

But how is this possible?

Jesus came to this world from the true and living God to save us from sin and enable us to have peace with God. Jesus died for our sins to make a way for us to have a relationship with God. *He sent me to heal the broken hearted, to preach deliverance to the captives... to set at liberty them that are bruised.* (Luke 4:18)
